New Member Recognition

Community Efforts

- Glenn Delk: 21st Century STEM Academy (http://21stcenturystem.academy/)
 - a NEW K thru 8 private school; located near Emory
 - School opening August 2016; 200 days a year
 - o Additional 3 to 4 schools opening next year
 - Anticipated school population: 80 to 100 students
 - Each student to receive Chromebooks along with personalized learning plans
 - Daily schedule: Set curriculum (4 hrs); enrichment activities (3 hrs)
 - School goal is to prepare students for high school
 - Cost: \$700/month (\$8,400 annually)
- Matt Lipkin regarding the Whitefoord Avenue mural
 - Edgewood residents voted on the artist Greg Mike, Outerspace Project @ http://www.outerspaceproject.com/ to complete the mural
 - Sample of the artist work was circulated; similar to his recent Inman Park mural
 - **Motion** for the ONE organization voted with the following (3) conditions:
 - 1. The local artist (Greg Mike)
 - 2. Completion of a SurveyMonkey made available to Edgewood neighbors allowing for input and feedback on the sketch/draft of the mural
 - 3. The ability to stop the project should the neighborhood decide NOT to proceed with the artist/mural design
 - ✓ Motion passed (17-0-4)



- Mural scheduled for completion during June 18th thru 25th
- MerryLeigh Giarra: Branding Campaign
 - Survey results from 34 participants indicated a desire for a new logo design.
 - A word cloud was created/displayed based on the survey feedback (such as diversity, walkability, Marta, proximity to downtown, etc.)

 - **Next steps:** Pursue more feedback from the neighbors; 34 is a small sampling and more input is needed from the neighborhood
